LAMPERT CIGARS

was founded by the lawyer Dr. Stefan Lampert.

The initial idea to create his own cigar brand crossed Stefan's mind in 2016 during a vacation in Thailand. Like many other vacationers, Stefan made use of the wide range of tailored suits on the market and wanted to transfer this concept of the tailored suit to a cigar. With his brand, he wanted to give customers the opportunity to create their very own handmade premium cigars as if in a laboratory, which is why he named his first cigar line MY CIGAR LAB - now the ORO LINE.

Because the MY CIGAR LAB line (now ORO LINE) was so well received in the cigar world, Stefan was determined to create a cigar that would take cigar aficionados further on his vacation trip. After trying various tobacco blends, one particular blend stuck out among the rest - the one with the salty taste. The salty notes of this cigar's unique blend reminded Stefan of the sea, leading him to name the cigar OCEAN BREEZE.

To create an even richer and more diverse range of cigars in the portfolio, Stefan looked for more cigar manufacturers in Central America, where he decided on Nicaragua because of the history and quality of the tobacco along with the exceptional cigar rollers.

The joint collaboration with the Ortez family began, and the cigar line LAMPERT 1675 Edición Azul was launched. The cigar line LAMPERT 1675 Edición Azul was such a success in Europe and the US that Stefan created the cigar line LAMPERT 1675 Edición Rojo in collaboration with the Ortez family.






The LAMPERT family was granted their first emblem in 1593. This emblem displays the color red and gold with a shield topped with a golden crown and striding lamb. The shield itself displays a castle with a golden roof on each side. Atop the shield rests the golden crown, a symbol of power and royalty. And rising from the crown is a striding lamb, symbolizing purity, wisdom, and joy. The first color is the heraldic gold, which surpasses the brilliance of all other metals and symbolizes prestige, virtue, and majesty. This transitions to the silver which symbolizes purity and wisdom. These colors are tied in with the red on the label, representing the patriotic spirit of chivalric service to the fatherland. Red represents victorious power and dominion. The most prominent colors on the label are gold and red. The heraldic gold, which surpasses the brilliance of all other metals and symbolizes prestige, virtue, and majesty. The red works with the gold, representing the patriotic spirit of chivalric service to the fatherland, victorious power, and dominion. Finally, silver closes out the label, representing purity and wisdom.

In 1675, the LAMPERT family was granted the second emblem. You will notice the predominant colors of blue (azure) and silver (argent) along with a lamb and crown. The blue in the emblem represents loyalty and constancy, much like the sapphire gemstone. In 1675, this meaning was taken to heart, and the color is still used to represent those same ideas on many flags today while also signifying hope for the future. Along with the blue color, silver is presented to represent the moon and the pearl. Both of these images are used throughout the world to represent purity, innocence, and joy. The emblem's lamb and crown complete the emblem with symbols of purity and power.

LAMPERT 1675 Edición AZUL is an extraordinary achievement by Fábrica AGROTABACOS, Nicaragua. The cigar offers rich, nuanced flavors that constantly evolve throughout the smoking experience. A full flavored, medium bodied cigar with a smooth finish.

This cigar blends the citrus notes of a high Peruvian priming (ligero) together with fillers grown, fermented, and aged by the ORTEZ family in the Jalapa and Condega valleys. The combination of the five-year-old Peruvian Pelo de Oro with three and four aged fillers delivers a decadent, smooth, and flavorful experience.

LAMPERT 1675 Edición ROJO is a medium-bodied, full-flavored cigar that was specifically blended to Stefan's specifications. The Edición ROJO embodies the complex, delicious, and rich flavor experience Stefan was looking for in a cigar with an Ecuadorian Connecticut wrapper.

The Rojo line uses an Ecuadorian Connecticut wrapper and a Nicaraguan binder and filler which were grown, fermented, and aged for four years by the ORTEZ family in the Jalapa and Condega valleys. Like the Edición Azul, the EDICIÓN ROJO is crafted by the cigar factory Fábrica AGROTABACOS, Nicaragua.

Notes of roasted espresso beans, dark cocoa, wood, and sweet spices emerge throughout an ample profile with a well-balanced finish.




